## FOOD AND BEVERAGE

### HALFWAY HOUSE:

Menu Options include a ‘Grab & Go’ set-up on course.

### PRIZE-GIVING:

Venue and standard décor are included in the admin fee. Halaal and kosher guests can be catered for at an additional cost.

Confirmation of number of guests is crucial in these cases.

### ON COURSE REFRESHMENTS:

Orders should be placed and paid for 7 (seven) working days prior to the golf day. Any late orders can be purchased at the bar on the day on consignment basis. Also refer to the Terms & Conditions inside the contract.

### CONFIRMATION:

Note that final number of golfers, halfway house and prize-giving dinner, must be confirmed in writing, 14 (fourteen) working days prior to the function. Rates are subject to changes with 30 calendar days’ prior notice. It is the organiser’s responsibility to ensure that their sponsors are aware that all drinks orders for the sponsored holes need to be placed with the caterers 7 (seven) working days prior to their golf day.

## FAST FACTS:

### GENERAL:

In order to secure your booking (unless a pre-paid deposit payment has already been made), a non-refundable deposit of

R 20,000 is required for green fees and carts and R 10,000 (if applicable) is required for the catering for your golf day. If the deposit is not received within 7 (seven) days after the date of your enquiry, the date of your golf booking will automatically be cancelled without any further communication. You will be invoiced for all items on your function sheet 7 (seven) working days before your golf day. Full payment required. The outstanding balance of your account must be paid within 2 (two) working days after the event.

### BRANDING:

Woodhill team will set up the on-course branding. Organiser to collect all banners from the sponsors, mark them clearly and deliver it to our caddy master, no later than 16:00 the day prior to the event. Banners & bags must be clearly marked with: Name of Company / Contact number of the sponsor / Allocated hole where banner must be erected. NB: All banners must be collected within 24 hours after the golf day. Woodhill does not accept any liability whatsoever after this period.

### NEAREST TO THE PIN & LONGEST DRIVE:

We prepare and place markers on the specified holes.

### INCLEMENT WEATHER:

Once the golf day has commenced and play has begun, Woodhill Country Club will as far as possible determine a result for prize-giving purposes, even if it is over 9 holes or less. We have an automated lightning measuring device that guides us in terms of when play should be stopped and recommenced. Should the golf course become unplayable due to weather conditions PRIOR to the commencement of the golf day, a replacement date suitable to both parties will be determined.

### SMOKING:

Kindly note that Woodhill is a non-smoking facility.

### DRESS CODE:

Please ensure that our Club dress code is conveyed to all your players, sponsors and guests to avoid embarrassment.

Please find the guidelines for both men and ladies below.

Below herewith please find the guidelines for both men and ladies:

## DRESS CODE: LADIES

	ON COURSE	OFF COURSE
<b>HEAD WEAR</b>	Traditional golf hats or peak caps. Caps to be worn with peak forward.	Hats and caps may not be worn in the clubhouse.
<b>SHIRTS</b>	Traditional collared or crew neck golf shirts to be tucked into trousers at all times. Tailored waist length ladies golf shirts need not be tucked in. Sleeveless golf shirts may also be worn	Regular collared shirts or crew neck golf shirts, tucked into trousers or skirts. Blouses may be worn over trousers and skirts.
<b>TROUSERS</b>	Traditional long or short golf trousers with belt or clasp. Formal three-quarter length golf trousers may be worn.	Long or short tailored trousers.
<b>SKIRTS</b>	Appropriate length golf skirts	Skirts with or without tailored jackets.
<b>SOCKS</b>	Short socks and anklets must be predominantly white, unless colour-coordinated with a golf outfit.	Short socks and anklets must be predominantly white, unless colour coordinated with outfit.
<b>SHOES</b>	Only closed heel golf shoes with soft spikes are permitted.	Formal or casual shoes and sandals.

## DRESS CODE: MEN

	ON COURSE	OFF COURSE
<b>HEAD WEAR</b>	Traditional golf hats or peak caps. Caps to be worn with peak forward.	Hats and caps may not be worn in the clubhouse.
<b>SHIRTS</b>	Traditional collared or crew neck golf shirts to be tucked into trousers at all times. No T-shirts allowed.	Regular collared shirts or crew neck golf shirts, tucked into trousers at all times. Tailored shirts may be worn over trousers.
<b>TROUSERS</b>	Traditional long or short golf trousers with belt or clasp. Formal three-quarter length golf trousers may be worn. No denims allowed.	Traditional long or short tailored trousers.
<b>SOCKS</b>	Traditional knee-length golf socks may be worn with short trousers. Short socks and anklets must be predominantly white or colour coded.	Socks must be worn with long trousers and if worn with golf shorts, must be predominantly white or colour-coded to outfit worn.
<b>SHOES</b>	Only closed heel golf shoes with soft spikes are permitted.	Casual shoes with closed heels may be worn without socks when wearing short trousers.

## NOTICE TO SPONSORS

Only A-frame, pop-up, tear drop and rotating banners on the course. No more than 6 banners per hole. Branding that should be erected on the course must be delivered to the organiser and the organiser will deliver to the Woodhill Caddy Master no later than 16:00 the day prior to the event.

Banners and banner bags must clearly be labelled with the company name, contact person, telephone number and hole number allocated.

Banners delivered on the day will only be attended to once our other operational requests have been completed. Banners are to be collected the day after the event, within 24 hours. Thereafter Woodhill does not accept responsibility. If banners are not received by 16h00 on the day prior to your event, this could lead to your branding exercise being compromised. Please ensure that this is attended to, per our request above. Woodhill Country Club accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to any equipment.

No vehicles are allowed on the course itself unless the Director of Golf has authorised it thus. Motor sponsors are only allowed behind the pro-tees of the 1st & 10th holes near the chipping area. No food or liquor from outside is allowed on the premises, over and above the two allocated holes by the organisation. Sponsors of watering holes must confirm the rules with Woodhill Country Club and catering partners beforehand. Please ensure that you include refreshments for caddies when making your watering hole arrangements prior to the day. No caddies are allowed any alcoholic refreshments.

Woodhill Country Club kindly requests that you adhere to the above as to avoid embarrassment to clients and guests. Caddies and players are not allowed in the Environmentally Protected Areas (black wooden poles indicate these areas) to look for balls under any circumstances.
